"It's their home, respect it."


You'd think since we build homes in this area, I would be sensitive to people and their living situations. Sometimes God must remind me,

Ygor says that he now will have a proper place for their daughter to be raised. He says it gives him a sense of pride and dignity.

They are very grateful and see the Hand of God working in their lives.








The Lord is moving in our church plant. We are getting new people each week and averaging around 3 people per week accepting Jesus. We even held our first baptism class.
