I am so anxious to see what God has for these kids and our school. It is and will be a greater testimony for this neighborhood and God.

We have a new church partnership, with Rendencao Church, Pastor Marcelo & Ana Borgno. They have a small congregation in Embu Guacu neighborhood and have been pastors for about 8 years. Before Covid they ran 7 cellular stores and were blessing the church with some of the profits. Covid brought a new reality and one by one he closed 5 stores. He did not just walk away, he paid all the rent and bills of the stores. He knew he had to honor God and not leave debts. He lost his house and they had to move in with Ana's mother. In all this he knew God would take care of them. They now have just one store and are out of debt. The church needs major repairs and that will be one of our first projects for 2023. We also will be building a small one-bedroom apartment above the church for the pastors. Soon they can move out of her parents' home. God is good!

Ana told me that for 5 years they have asked their people to bring in food to make the food packages. She said every month they asked and every month the most they received was enough to make 5 packages. Their people just do not have the means to have enough to give food away. So now they are in our feeding program and receive 35 packages a month. Marcelo and Ana just want to thank God and you for all these blessings.
