She came to us desperate, depressed, an alcoholic with no job, and no food for her children. She had no self-control, was fighting all the time, separated from her husband and suicidal. A neighbor told her about our project, and she only came because we were offering food. She had no interest in God or listening, but those were the rules and she was desperate.

Her change was gradual, but intense. She is now a member of the church, and her marriage has been restored. She testifies and shares her transformation with everyone she meets.

She is no longer in our Hope program because her and her husband have found permanent jobs and are able to support their family with dignity. Their new journey is one of faith, hope, and God's miraculous power to change a situation of pain and tragedy into a victory of triumph.
